Residents and businesses in Sandwell are being urged to have their say on what improvements they would like to see as part of the Government's Towns Fund £75 million investment in Sandwell.

There will be £25 million available per town selected to develop innovative regeneration plans.

Last year, the Government announced that 101 towns would benefit from the Towns Fund deal – including West Bromwich, Rowley Regis and Smethwick - in Sandwell.

This is a really exciting opportunity to bring investment into Sandwell, we want to hear from as many people as possible.
