The major highway scheme plans to:

- Widen each arm of Birchley Island
- Widen both roundabouts and the link road between them
- Coordinated traffic signals to improve capacity at busy times
- Improved routes for cyclists and pedestrians

The new design will cut waiting times at the junction, reducing emissions from queuing traffic.

This will result in improvements in local air quality and Sandwell's reductions in NO₂ emissions will contribute towards meeting the Government's national targets for air quality and climate change.
