Book a test if you test positive at home

♥ Thank you to everyone doing twice weekly Covid-19 rapid tests at home. ♥

But remember, if you test positive using a rapid test, you MUST [book a PCR test at a test centre within 48 hours](#) and start to self-isolate for ten full days, or until you get a negative PCR result.



If you have symptoms, you MUST book a PCR test and self-isolate. Symptoms for Covid-19 are a high temperature, a new continuous cough, or a change to your sense of taste or smell.
