

Payments for Foster Carers

Guide to payments for foster carers for 2021/2022







Foster carers receive a fee and a maintenance allowance for each child in their care. The level of fee is dependent upon the skills of the carer and the maintenance allowance is paid according to the age of the child.

Current fees and allowances are detailed below.

Note - movement between skill levels (progression) is dependent upon the skill levels of the carers. Details are available in the <u>Foster Carer Guide to</u> <u>Progression</u>.

Fees and allowances are paid fortnightly. Carers are treated as selfemployed and are advised to seek the advice of an accountant.

Equipment

Sandwell Children's Trust supports foster carers in ensuring they have safe and appropriate equipment for children in their care.

Pocket money and savings

Carers are required to make savings for each child in their care. £5.00 weekly is to be saved for each child up until the age of 16, when the expectation is £10.00 weekly. The weekly sum comes from the carers' maintenance allowance.

Extra money (e.g. gifts at birthdays or from families) can be paid into the savings account.

Children are also entitled to receive pocket money commensurate with their age.
