- Bring your vaccine card if you've had your first dose

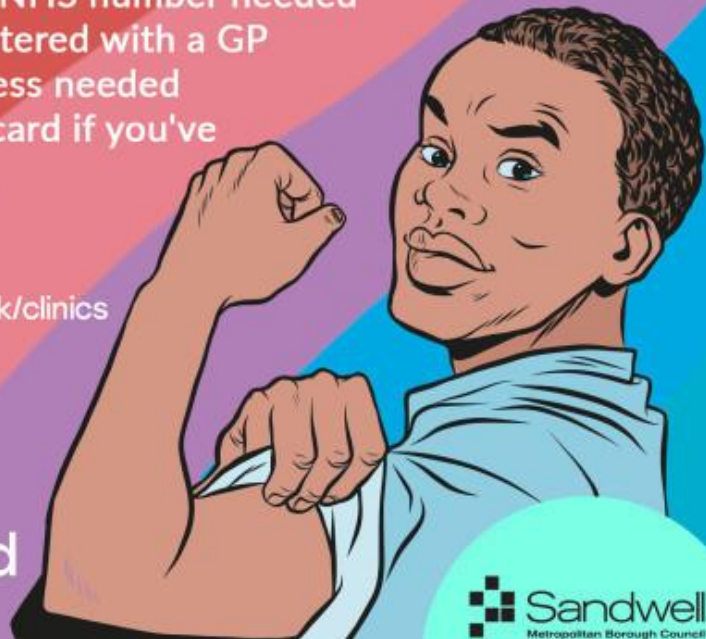

🌳 Plans also include a dedicated walking and cycling route with a tree-lined corridor along Bull Street.

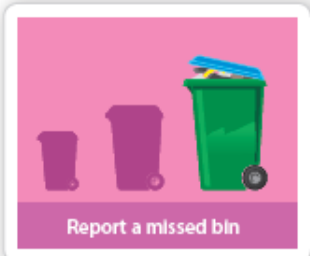
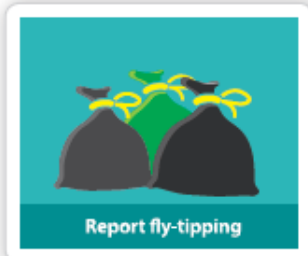
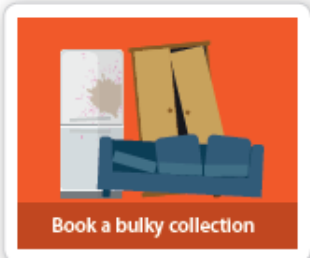
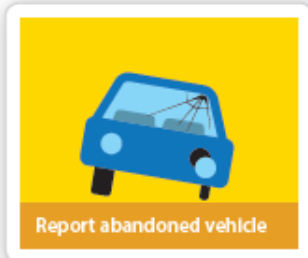
