 Walk in Monday-Sunday at Tipton Sports Academy, Wednesbury Oak Road, Tipton, DY4 0BS. Every day 8am-6pm. AstraZeneca and Pfizer available.

 If you need an evening jab, go to Portway Lifestyle Centre, Newbury Lane, Oldbury, B69 1HE. Monday to Friday from 6pm-8pm. Also open weekends from 8.30am-1.30pm. AstraZeneca and Pfizer available.

 There are also lots of pharmacies across Sandwell offering the vaccine as well as our vaccine bus clinics.

Jabs at The Hawthorns

Pop along to the Baggies ground at The Hawthorns tomorrow (Saturday). First and second dose Covid-19 vaccines are available 10am to 6pm.

- Only Pfizer available
- No NHS number needed
- No need to be registered with a GP
- No residential address needed
- Bring your vaccine card if you have already had your first dose
- For people aged 18 and over
