

You will learn how to use Microsoft Teams for meetings and to keep in touch with friends and family, how to sending emails with attachments and how to research and find information on the Internet



#### Overview

Exploitation is one of the fastest growing crimes in the world. Many children who are exploited may have experienced sexual abuse as part of being controlled or because they are vulnerable. This course enables you to gain knowledge and awareness of the issues that surround this topic and the impact that organised abuse has on Children & Young People.

- Develop an understanding of the difficulties in the attachment process
- Understand behaviour is a form of communication
- Know strategies to support a range of challenging behaviours
- Consider strategies to help children understand and manage their emotions

## Workshop to Raise the Awareness of Prevent (WRAP)

#### Overview

WRAP is designed make you aware about your contribution in preventing vulnerable people being exploited for extremist or terrorist purposes. This workshop improves the understanding of the processes used by those who radicalise individuals and ensures that you know whom to contact within the Trust to discuss any concerns.

#### Learning Outcomes

- An understanding of the Prevent agenda and your role within it.
- The ability to use your existing expertise and professional judgement to recognise potentially vulnerable individuals and know when an intervention may be necessary to support them.
- Knowledge of when, how and where to refer concerns about vulnerable individuals.

#### **Tots Talking**

Quality Early Years & Childcare Team

Tots Talking is a new pilot project with ICAN 8 weeks x 1 hour workshops (on line training with practical fun ideas and resources!)

#### What is it about?

Tots Talking is a programme developed by parents/carers for parents/carers to support them to improve the language of their 2-year-old children, at risk of delayed language. It does this by encouraging parents/carers to use contingent language and behaviours to support children's language and communication skills.

The sessions are supported by the Tots Talking App which parents/carers can use on their phone.

The App gives information to help parents/carers learn and encourage them to practice what they have learned with their child at home.

#### What is the Chat, Play, Read all about?

**Read**: sharing books, singing nursery rhymes, parents and children talking together....about anything, any time, any place, anywhere.
