Covid vaccinations for children and young people in care

As a Trust, we have sought advice from our Designated Doctor and Named Nurse for Children in Care and based on the advice we have received, we support the vaccination programme for children aged 12-17 years

We believe that children should be able to consent if they are deemed to be Gillick Competent. They should be given information by their social worker to help them make an informed choice. We've included the links to <u>some helpful information</u> to support this discussion

All consent forms will be signed by the Head of Service for Children in Care as this is not a routine vaccination where consent can be given through delegated authority.

EU Settlement Scheme

The UK government set up the EU Settlement Scheme to enable EU citizens to continue to live, work and study in the UK after the 31st December 2020 when the transition period for the UK's withdrawal from the European Union ended.

The deadline for application was 30th June 2021. However, the Home Office will consider late applications in certain circumstances and this currently includes applications for children. For further information click <u>here</u>.
